Welcome: After a great breakfast and great fellowship, President Mike Futrell, called the meeting to order at 7:55 AM with an explanation (full of laughter) of the Hiram Sessoms Investment Group, which is a fictitious corporation brought about by an unsuccessful attempt by someone by that name to scam ACMA out of a significant sum of money. And then led in prayer.

Devotions: Our host, Transformation Network's (T-Net) Bob Buford brought a devotional using T-Net's foundational verse (Ephesians 2:10), Ephesians 2:1-10, and a bicycling analogy. He then introduced Stanley Frankhart who is leading a new effort in Ashland called Young Christian Professionals (YCP). Stanley then explained the new ministry which will launch in April.

Minutes: The minutes, which had been sent out and are on the website, were received and adopted as presented.

Times-Gazette Articles: Mike reminded the group of the weekly assignments for the pastor's column are on the website. (ashlandcma.org)

Treasurer: Treasurer, Ben Roby, presented the financials, which had been sent out and are on the website, with extensive explanation of the transactions over the past month especially in light of the Unite the Night funds that had been raised and distributed. The report was accepted as presented.

Nominating Committee: Scot Myers, who by virtue of his office as ACMA Vice President per stipulation of the ACMA Constitution which was adopted in November of 2017, is the Chairperson of the Nomination Committee. Scot announced that he has almost completed assembling the committee which needs to bring nominees for Treasurer and Secretary. Ben Roby, who will be finishing an uncompleted term has agreed to be the nominee for Treasurer.

Community Prayer Breakfast update: John Bouquet reported that planning is coming along well for the May 3 event which is the biggest annual ACAM event. He shared that county official invitation packets were available and had been distributed (with two still to be assigned). Karen Hetrick gave a quick tutorial on the mailings, the need to keep to the proscribed schedule and make needed follow-up. She also explained the new sponsor and seating info.

Community Good Friday Service: Ron Marenchin updated us on the service sign-ups and passed the sign-up worship folder around again to fill in blanks and so we could verify information if we had already signed up.

Power To Connect (Fostering Families): John Bouquet filled in in Sherry's absence. He reported that there are 20 families who are trained and ready or actually serving as foster families. He added that there are 42 kinship families who provide support of various kinds to the foster families. And then he gave the statistic of 141 kids in foster care. Jon Hall added that there will be a training event called Power to Connect on April 13 and 14 to help people who deal with trauma.

Ashland Pregnancy Care Center: Melanie Miller gave us some background on APCC's fundraising banquet next month and reminded us of the need for table sponsors. She also gave background on the speaker.

One Minute Memos (Announcements): Mike Futrell

- Sam Speck reported on the Unite the Night event. Over 200 kids attended and quite a number made first time commitments to Christ as well as even more rededications.
- He also shared about a time of prayer for pastors at Crestview on March 14 on the day of the school walkout. There will also be a forum in the afternoon with school and local officials.

Group Prayer: Jon Hall led the group into prayer to end the meeting.
