**Welcome:** After a fabulous breakfast and great fellowship, President Mike Futrell, called the meeting to order with prayer at 7:58 AM.

**Devotions:** Our host, Joe Keim, brought a devotional from the book of Titus speaking of the need for mature Christ Followers to mentor younger ones. He also gave a synopsis of his journey and of how the Lord has brought MAP Ministry to where it is with the many Bible studies mailed out, Beyond Measure Market, and the housing.

**Minutes:** The minutes, which had been sent out and are on the website, were received and adopted as presented. Bob Buford made the motion and Eric Abel was the 2<sup>nd</sup>.

**Treasurer:** Treasurer, Ben Roby, presented the financials, which had been sent out and are on the website. He made note of the flurry of activity in the financials what with the Community Prayer Breakfast. He reports that most CPB bills have been paid and most pledges have been received. The financial situation for ACMA is very good. The report was received as presented.

**Community Prayer Breakfast update:** John Bouquet shared some more follow-up. It was a very good year though not without some struggles for the planners, especially Bethel.

### Election of Officers

Treasurer – Ben Roby was unanimously elected for a new term. He had just completed the final year of Scot Myers who had moved to Vice President in 2017.

Secretary – Melanie Miller was unanimously elect for a new term. She is replacing Keith Tyson whose term has ended.

### One Minute Memos (Announcements):

- Jon Hall informed the group that Job & Family Services (JFS) has a new director and that in conversation it has come to light that a meeting room at the JFC office is badly in need of refurbishing and a playground needs to be added. He proposed \$1,000 from ACMA (\$500) and NDP (\$500) be contributed for this. The question was raised about the integrity of using NDP funds which are given in good faith for the Community Prayer Breakfast. So the proposal was amended to have the full \$1,000 come from ACMA general fund. The motion passed.
- The principal of Mapleton Elementary School, Michelle Roblin, presented the opportunity for a church or churches to provide the after-care program there for the coming school year.
- An update was provided for Fostering Family Ministries
- Mike Futrell shared about Brethren Care Village's new Bistro desiring to have coffee mugs from local entities including churches.
- Ron Marenchin shared a newspaper clipping from 1912 concerning the formation of the Ashland County Ministerial Association.
